

Fares & Payment:

The one-way **WorxLink** fare is **\$3.00**. We accept cash in the exact amount of the fare, and we also accept the **Token Transit** mobile pay app.

Token Transit lets you prepay fares, activate them when you need them, then show the driver your virtual ticket, all on your mobile device! Learn more and download the app for Apple or Android using the QR code below. Then you can just **"Show & Go!"**



Service Rules & Notes:

- All schedule times are for departures
- All times are cell phone based
- Riders must be ready for the bus to arrive
- Bus may run late depending on conditions
- Seatbelt and child seat use is required by law
- No standing while the bus is in motion
- No paper or Styrofoam cups
- No open-top drink containers
- No smoking, vaping, or using illegal substances
- No opened alcoholic beverages
- No weapons or dangerous goods
- Electronics must not bother other riders
- No abusive, threatening or obscene language
- No lewd gestures or uncivil behavior
- Shirts and footwear must be worn
- Do not throw objects from the bus window
- No operation of, or tampering with, the bus
- Packages must be carried aboard in one trip
- Packages must be secured safely at the rider's seat or at a location specified by the driver
- Packages may not be left on the bus
- Only trained service animals, under control of the rider, are permitted.

WorxLink is a public subscription bus service in Lewiston and Auburn, providing reservation-based, curb-to-curb workforce transportation, Monday-through-Friday and limited Saturday operation.

If you live and work anywhere in the greater Lewiston ~ Auburn metro area, and need transportation to and from work, at a time, or place, not served by **citylink**, **WorxLink** may be able to provide you with curb-to-curb transportation.

Reservations are required and may be made by calling **207-784-9335**, selection **1**, Monday-Friday from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, except listed holidays. Recurring reservations will be accepted. Seating is on a first-come-first-served basis.

WorxLink, as part of The Maine Jobs & Recovery Plan, is a pilot workforce transportation initiative, operated by Western Maine Transportation Services, with grant funding from the Elmina B. Sewall Foundation, MaineDOT and Federal Transit Administration, in cooperation with Strengthen LA.

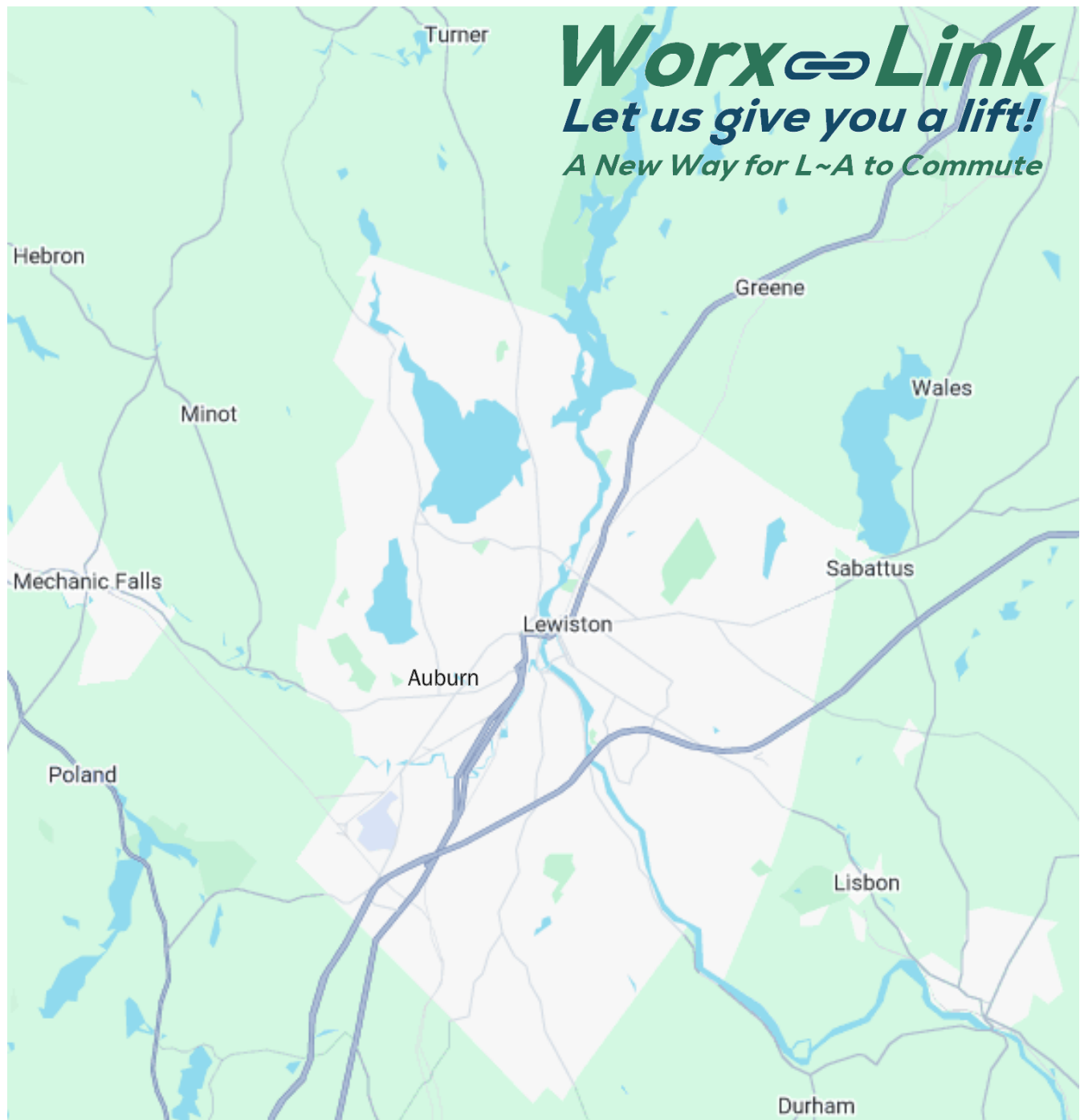
